#1502 in Crystal Tower brought forth attention to the council regarded the recurrence of water ingress from the roof despite previous repairs had been done. It appeared to be caused by a misaligned flashing on the roof top, the agent will recall the roofer to repair the fragment. The owner has also produced an outstanding reminder from the management office which was carried over from the previous billing on a bathroom flood caused the ceiling damaged to the unit below.
